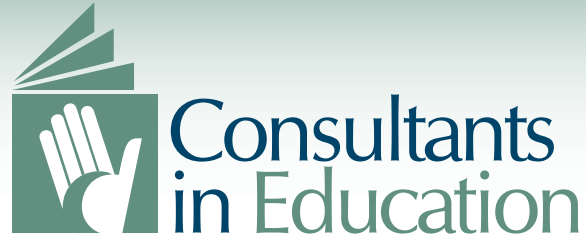


# What is CIE?

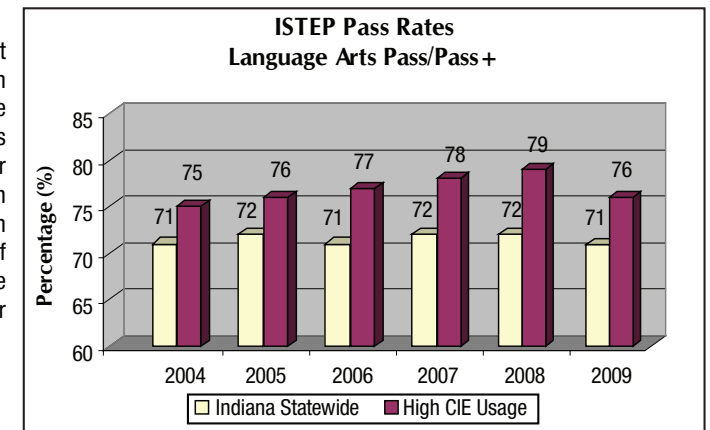

Recent score results on the Indiana ISTEP test indicate that Consultants in Education has been impacting schools beyond simply teaching the topics.
